## **Addendum to School Behaviour Policy for COVID-19 Safety Precautions**

This addendum applies until further notice.

It sets out additions to our normal behaviour policy. Pupils, parents and staff should continue to follow our normal behaviour policy with respect to anything not covered in this addendum.

We may need to amend or add to this addendum as circumstances or official guidance changes. We will communicate any changes to staff, parents and pupils.

When pupils are in school, we expect them to follow all of the rules set out below to keep themselves and the rest of the school community safe.

Staff will be familiar with these rules and make sure they are followed consistently.

Parents should also read the rules and ensure that their children follow the new procedures that have been put in place. Parents should contact Mrs J. Humphrey if they think their child will need support to comply with some or all of the rules.

### Behaviours which we see as contravening safety instructions may include

- Not following the altered routines for arrival and departure
- Not following the school instructions on hygiene
- Not following instructions around how children can socialize within school
- Not moving around the school using the altered routes and instructions
- Not taking responsibility within age expectations, for using tissues to catch sneezes and disposing of them in the lidded bins
- Not following the expectations around coughing and spitting at or towards other children or adults
- Not following the expectations about sharing any equipment
- Not following the amended expectations around play and lunchtimes, including where children may play and the equipment they have access to
- Not following expectations and routines about access to the toilets, turn taking, allowing other children time and space

We expect children and their carers to inform us immediately if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus

All children will be made aware of the new routines and instructions at the start of the new school year, each week and reminders given when necessary. However, children may face consequences should they continue to not adhere to these expectations once given the chance to do so – i.e if they continue to behave with no regard for the safety of others, their actions are purposeful. Staff will give verbal warnings, may make a call home to speak with parents and use sanctions in line with the school behaviour policy.

### Remote learning rules

If children are not in school, we expect parents to ensure that

- They are contactable during the school day
- Complete learning set by teachers
- Seek help from their teacher if they need it

- Use proper online conduct, such as using appropriate language in messages

We will review this policy as guidance from the local authority or Department for Education is updated, and as a minimum, every two weeks. Every review will be approved by the IEB.
